Perhaps none better in history except perhaps George Washington himself (although as Commander in Chief he lost a lot more battles than you ever did, at least, in the beginning). You have my gratitude for restoring hope to our military and to our nation during your service as President.

I hope you will understand, my thanks will be a lot more effusive and enthusiastic, if you could make sure one of your last acts before you leave office, is to pardon me. Sir, I am very serious.

I don't think it is fair, that because I did my job in combat, my entire life has to be ruined. Others with combat service, have access to jobs after. As a convicted felon, my prospects of a decent job are almost zero. Other combat veterans have VA benefits and access to medical care. After combat and then after 10 years at Ft. Leavenworth mostly in solitary confinement, I do not, much as this is needed. Most people have their honor after their service. They took that away from me and branded me a war criminal.

Sir, you are my last hope to Restore Honor, to restore my life. Please help me. Read the cover letter signed by fellow combat veteran, Lt. My appeal to Heaven is that this plea catches your favorable attention and that you will give me the mercy I have prayed for, a Presidential Pardon. Thank you for your consideration. God bless you, and America.
